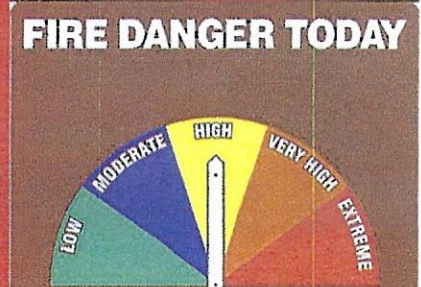
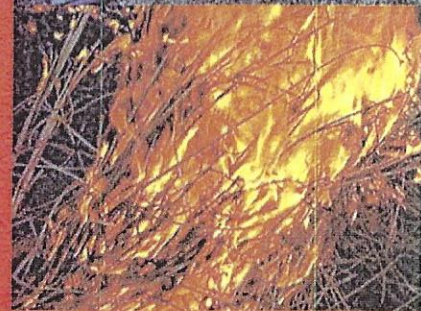
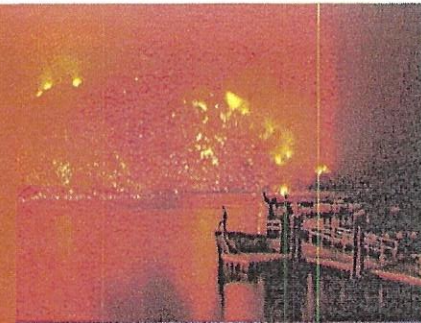


Wildfire Safety in Northwest Montana

1. Make sure that your camp fire is dead out, cold to the touch.
2. Don't park your car in grass or brush that the hot muffler could start a fire.
3. If you are pulling a trailer make sure the safety chains are not touching the roadway they can cause sparks.
4. Don't discard cigarettes, matches, or smoking materials on the ground.
5. Know the current wildfire conditions and fire restrictions for the area you are traveling.

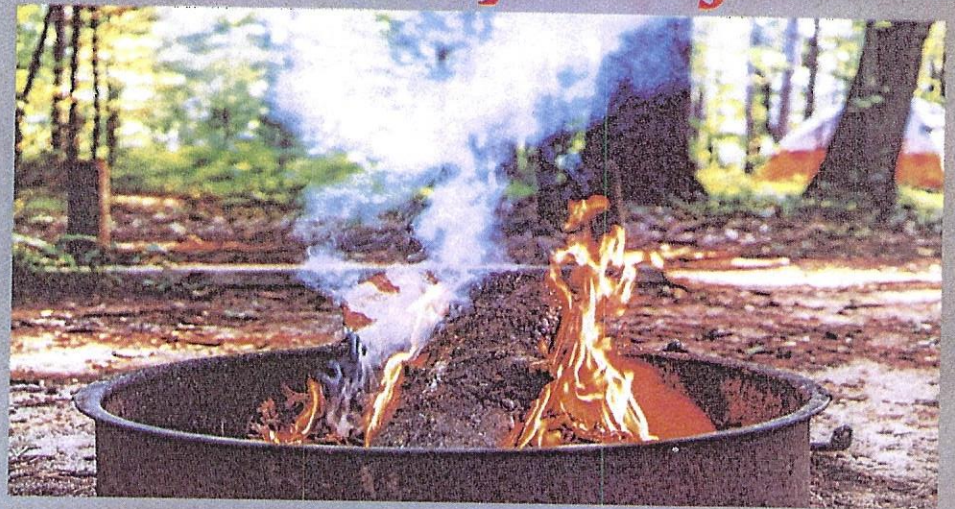
